Monday	James 1	Job 1-2, 42	v2 says we should count trials as joy! Read about Job's trials and how they worked out in his life. How does this encourage your faith in trials?
Tuesday	James 2	Leviticus 19	v8 quotes the Law to love your neighbor as yourself. Read the entire chapter to get the context of being holy as the Lord is holy.
Wednesday	James 3	Psalms 12, 14 & 15	v6 says our tongue is unrighteous. Read two chapters from the psalms that are examples of evil speech. Read one chapter of an example of someone who is right with God.
Thursday	James 4	Proverbs 4	v8 says we need to purify our hearts. Read the wisdom of how to guard our hearts in Proverbs 4 especially verse 23 and following.
Friday	James 5	1 Kings 17-18	v17 mentions how Elijah prayed. Read these two chapters about Elijah and how it did not rain for 3 1/2 years. What can you learn from his example?
