

SCRIPTURE OF THE DAY:

Double Down on 1 John!

Monday	1 John 1	Psalm 51	v9 promises that when we confess our sins God will forgive us. Read about how David experienced this promise in Psalm 51.
Tuesday	1 John 2	Jeremiah 31	v27 says that we have been anointed and do not need to be taught because we know God. Read Jeremiah 31 about our New Covenant relationship with God.
Wednesday] 1 John 3	Genesis 3	v11-15 refer to Cain and Abel. Read Genesis 4 to get the full story as we study the antithesis between hate and love.
Thursday	1 John 4	Dueteronomy 13, 18:15-22	v1-6 give us a doctrinal test to see if a message is really from God. Go back to the Law to evaluate false prophets and then the prophecy of the true Prophet.
Friday	1 John 5	Exodus 32	v21 warns us about idols. See how the Israelites fell into idolatry so we can learn from their example.
