#4. Read **Matthew 5:23-24**. Why is it so important to God that we are reconciled with other Christians?

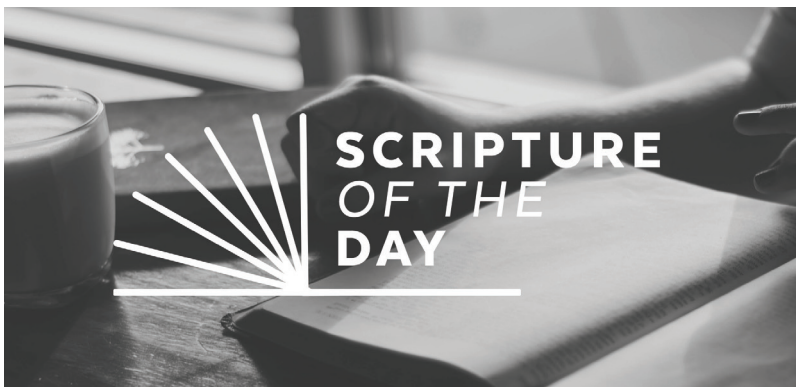
#5. Read **Colossians 3:12-14**. How has becoming a Christian changed the way you interact with other people?
