Reading from the Law

Monday ~ Genesis 1-3

Read John 1:1-3, Colossians 1:15-18 and Hebrews 1:1-3. Even though his name is not mentioned in the Creation account of Genesis 1, what role did Jesus play?

Tuesday ~ Genesis 4-5

Read 1 John 3:11-18. After reading about Cain and Abel, what is something you can actually do today to love someone in deed and truth?

Wednesday ~ Genesis 6-7

Read Matthew 24:36-39. Are you ready? Who can you pray for today that they will repent and get ready before it is too late?

Thursday ~ Genesis 8-9

Draw a rainbow or put up a picture of a rainbow somewhere in your house to remind you of God's promise. Tell someone what the rainbow really means today.

Friday - Genesis 10-11

Read Matthew 28:18-20. How often do you think of people from other countries or who speak other languages getting saved? What can you do to spread the gospel to them?
