#### Monday ~Genesis 12-14

**Read Hebrews 11:8-10.** What can you learn from Abraham's example of faith? What is God telling you to do that you need to obey today?

#### Tuesday ~ Genesis 15-17

**Read Galatians 3:1-9.** Who does this passage say are the sons of Abraham? What does it mean by "hearing with faith?" When did you hear the word of Christ and believe it to be saved?

#### Wednesday ~Genesis 18-20

WARNING: Reading through Genesis is going to lead us into graphic accounts of sin. Parents are encouraged to read through the Scripture first and consider in wisdom how to lead their children.

When was the last time you got together with brothers or sisters in Christ for the sole purpose of prayer?

#### Thursday ~Genesis 21-23

**Read James 2:18-26.** Why is it so important that even though we are saved by faith alone, the faith that saves is never alone but always leads to works in our lives?

#### Friday ~Genesis 24-26

What is a promise God has made in the Bible you are trusting in today?
