Application Questions

1. **Read Hebrews 10:24-25.** How would you rate your level of “consideration” in 2019? How often did you think about the spiritual growth of other Christians? Is there anything that needs to change in 2020?
2. **Read Matthew 22:34-38 and 1 Corinthians 13:1-3.** What is the danger if what we do is not motivated by love? How can you encourage someone with the love that God has for them so that they can pass it on to others?
3. **Read Ephesians 2:10 and Matthew 28:19-20.** How well do you know what “good works” God has commanded us to do? What will you do to know God’s commands well enough so that you can incite others to obey them?
4. **Read Proverbs 18:1.** What are some of the ways you have been tempted to isolate yourself in the past? What have been your excuses for not being close with other Christians at your church? How will you neglect those excuses moving forward?
5. **Read Ephesians 4:15-16** Who are the other Christians that you are “jointed” together with here at our church? What smaller group of people are you committing to love in 2020? If you are not a part of a fellowship group here at the church, speak with Pastor Daniel about joining one in 2020!
6. **Read Hebrews 10:25-27.** How will you increase your level of encouragement in 2020? How will the return of Christ and his judgment for sin increase your level of urgency to encourage your one anothers?
