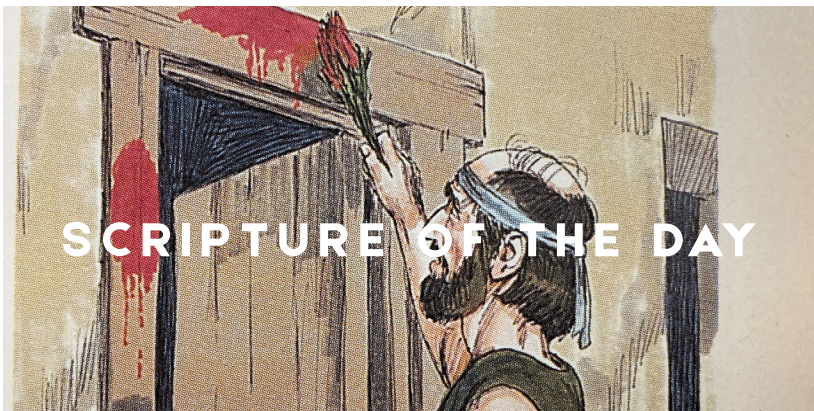
#1. Now that you have heard this sermon about the Passover, what are you going to do about it?
