

Choose Life


Deuteronomy 30:15-20

ways, and by keeping his
commandments and his

and the Lord your God
will bless you in the land
that you are entering to
take possession of it.
17 But if your heart turns

hear, but are drawn away
to worship other gods and
serve them,
18 I declare to you today,
that you shall surely perish.

the land that you are going
over the Jordan to enter
and possess.
19 I call heaven and

you today, that I have

20 loving the Lord your

days, that you may dwell
