

**1** So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed:

**3** not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock.

**4** And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.

**5** Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." esv
