Application Questions

These questions are for you to do by yourself or with your spouse. They are to prepare you for a discussion about the sermon at a fellowship group. - #4. What can you learn from the examples of Peter (Luke 22:31-32) and Paul (2 Timothy 4:16-18) and even Jesus (Psalm 22:12-20) when they met with the lions' mouth?
- #5. What can you do now to prepare for the reality that Satan is prowling and could come for you?

What do you think he would tempt you or deceive you or accuse you about?

What specifically can you put your faith in to stand firm?
