APPLICATION QUESTIONS

#1. **Romans 10:13** “For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved!”

The main point of this sermon is for those who are still in sin to call on the name of Jesus and be saved!

If you have already called on Jesus before hearing this sermon, what are you going to do in response to this verse?

#2. **Read Deuteronomy 6:4-7.** How do we make sure we are not just going through the motions “doing” or “saying” the right things? How do we make sure we are responding to God from our heart, with all we are?

(Will you commit to reading Deuteronomy with the rest of us and learning more about this heart response to love God? YES or NO)

#3. **Read Isaiah 30:1-5.** As you remember your own salvation, what were you trusting in as a foundation for your life before Christ? How is your new foundation in Christ more sure than what you were trusting in before?

#4. **Read Joel 2:28-32.** As we continue to pray for others to be saved and get ready to share the gospel with them, is there anyone you are tempted to think is beyond the saving power of Jesus? Are there certain groups of people you don't think Jesus will save?

Romans 9 & 10 REVIEW: The antinomy of divine sovereignty and human responsibility. Are you seeing BOTH how God called us in Christ and how we call on the name of Jesus to be saved?

What can you learn from Paul's flow of thought going straight from Romans 9 into Romans 10?
