



SUMMER CAMP FAQ'S

Registration

Question: When will be the last day to register?

Answer: June 22, 2025

Question: Is there a sibling discount?

Answer: Yes. Each sibling gets \$15 off. (1st student - \$515, 2nd student - \$500)

Transportation

Question: Will transportation be provided?

Answer: Yes. Students will be transported with leaders on chartered buses.

Question: Where and when should we drop off and pick up students?

Answer: Drop off students at Revival building (15272 Revival Circle, HB) on June 23rd at 8:00am. On Monday, students should come having eaten breakfast and with a packed lunch for the bus, as we will drive through lunch time to get straight to camp. Pick up students at Revival building on June 27th at 2:00pm.

At Camp

Question: What are the sleeping arrangements and how many adults will be with the students?

Answer: We will have gender specific walled tents on separate sides of the camp. There will be at least 2 adults in each tent sleeping with the students.

Question: What measures will be taken to ensure the safety of my child?

Answer: We are bringing 2 adults to serve on our "Medical Team". They are trained EMT's or RN's. They will constantly be around for the purpose of injuries or medication.

Question: How many sessions will there be and what will they involve?

Answer: Pastor Bobby is coming to teach 4 different main sessions from John 17 on Eternal Life!

Question: What types of games will be played and how intense will they be?

Answer: Students will be playing strategic games in water and on land. Students will be encouraged to participate in all activities but forced to do none.

Question: What measures will be taken to safely supervise my child?

Answer: Students will never be left alone. We are bringing extra volunteers to have more adults around for the purpose of providing supervision.

Communication & Technology

Question: What is the electronics policy at camp?

Answer: Our desire is for students to have a week unplugged from the world, connecting to the Lord. Because of this, students can bring their phones on the bus, but once they are at camp, we will have them turn in their phone to not use it during the week.

Question: What if I need to contact my child during the week?

Answer: We are bringing a camp receptionist. The camp receptionist is a parent. We will provide you with their phone number when you sign up upon request so if you have any need to contact your child, you can call them day or night.
